

WOW Activity Tracker – Acceptable Use Policy

The WOW Activity Tracker is an online platform, provided by Living Streets, which encourages everyday physical activity. It enables pupils to log their activity (when learning from home) or journey to school each day and be in with a chance to earn a reward.

By participating and logging journeys and physical activity on the WOW Activity Tracker, you are agreeing to the guidelines set out below.

Pupils should only record their own activity

Each pupil has been allocated an individual icon and should only record activity against that icon. Recording activity for other pupils is misleading and could be experienced as bullying.

Pupils should be honest about what they have been able to do

The WOW Activity Tracker aims to help pupils become more active, but pupils should not exaggerate what they have achieved. If it has not been possible to walk or exercise on a given day, then one of the non-active modes should be selected.

Pupils should respect their peers' privacy

The WOW Activity Tracker should be seen as an extension of the classroom, information about pupils' activity should not be shared outside the class.

We expect all online activity to be conducted to the same safeguarding and behaviour standards as you would see in the classroom at Grendon Primary School.
