### settling into school/



The children have done really well settling back into school life after a long holiday.

Most children have remembered our rules but we thought it would be a good idea to have a quick reminder:

- School opens at 8:50am. Parents/children should **not** be on site before this time.
- Children have to be in their lines at 8.55am
- Late children have to be brought to the School Office by an adult to provide a reason. If a child has a medical appointment please bring in proof.
- All absences have to be reported by 9.30am and a reason provided.
- Children need their Book Bags and PE kits in school every day.
- Dinner money must be paid on Monday mornings either weekly or for the term.
- Changes to dinner arrangements need to be given 2 weeks in advance in person to the Office.
- Please send your child in with a drink of water in a named bottle.
- Water Bottles can be bought for 40p from the Office and can be re-filled during the school day.
- School uniform needs to be worn at all times and labelled clearly. Shoes and not **BOOTS or TRAINERS** should be worn in school.
- Please see teachers at the end of the day or make an appointment to see them - mornings are very busy!
- Trip money and consent forms must be returned by the deadline given unless you have made arrangements with the School Office.
- Staff are happy to help with any questions you may have, **the best time to speak to your child's teacher is at the end of the day or you can make an appointment through the School Office.**

Dinner Money is £10.25 a week or £77.90 for this half term.

Pizza Day is Friday and costs £16.40 for this half term.

**Please give 2 Weeks notice** if you wish your child to change their dinner arrangements.


### Well Done Reception!
