Welcome back to school! We are very excited to meet your children and to work with them in Year One.

Children need a PE kit in school. Ideally this will be in a draw string bag as they are kept on children's pegs. Our PE days are on a Tuesday and Thursday.

Please label all coats, jumpers, cardigans and hats with your child's name. This helps us to re-unite clothing with the right children.

Children need to bring a bottle of tap water and a healthy snack each day. We do provide fruit daily in school. Please do not store snacks and drinks in children's bookbags.

Children need their book bags in school everyday. We have the bookbags in school at the moment and will send the first reading books home on Monday.

We will set homework weekly on a Friday. Please read your child's RWI books at home at least 3 times each week and write in the reading record each time. You will find the spellings to learn on the class page of the school website. Children should also access their Numbots game each week. Each half term we will also set a longer homework project linked to our in class learning.

If your child is likely to have a toileting accident, please provide a set of spare clothes in a carrier bag. We do have some spare clothes in school. If your child comes home in borrowed clothes please wash and return the items as soon as possible.
