Dear Parents and Carers,

In Year 3 this half term term, the theme for your child's learning in PSHE will be all about '**Valuing Difference**'.

As part of this theme...

- Children learn about relationships with their family and friends
- They consider the many different relationships in different family groups including traditional families, blended families, single parent families, single-sex families and families formed through fostering and adoption.
This lesson is part of our normal SCARF PSHE Scheme and this particular lesson has been flagged as 'sensitive but not optional' as the lesson considers some family units with same-sex parents. - Children consider stereotypes and prejudice
- They consider diversity and discuss tolerance, respect and bullying using the Ugly Duckling story
- Children develop strategies for if they are ever bullied or abused online
