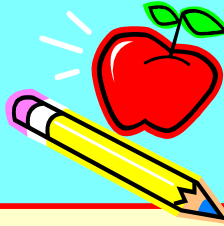

### About?

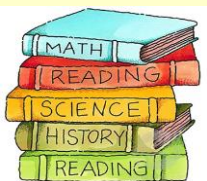
Welcome back children and parents. We have all been very impressed with the children's resilience as they return to Grendon and look forward to the rest of the term.
