### Dear Parents,

We have almost reached the end of another busy school year and I'd like to say a big thank you for your support during the year - we couldn't do it without you! We look forward to a new year and seeing what we can achieve with all the exciting things planned. We wish Year 6 children all the best with your move to secondary schools in September. We will say our proper goodbyes at the Prom and Leavers Assembly next week

As part of our new behaviour policy, which we will share in September, we are introducing a House system at Grendon.

This year all children have been split into a houses - you may have heard about this after our House Day this week!

Next year's Reception class will be split in a graduation ceremony at the end of their Reception year in July 2024, and this will become an annual event, with Reception children graduating before they move to Year 1 each year.

After much thought and consideration, we are naming our houses after people who are aspirational because of their achievements in their field. They all have strong connections to Birmingham and feature throughout our curriculum. Children will find out more about them during their time at Grendon. Children will work all year during our usual curriculum and enrichment days to win points for their team. This becomes another way for us to reward the excellent behaviour we see so often. On House day at the end of each year, the winning team will win a trophy! Please find out which House your child is in, and support them in their quest to win points - good luck everybody!




Some of our very talented musicians had the opportunity to perform in Symphony Hall in Birmingham this week as part of the Services for Education Youth Proms event.
