Important Reminders



Gates open at 8:40am. Registration takes place at 8:50am.

- It is parents/carers responsibility to report a child's absence. You need to call the office before 9:00am Please clearly state your child's name and class and reason. For absence.
- Children who arrive after 8:50am are late and must be brought to the School Office by an adult to provide a reason. A late slip will be given.
- If your child has a medical appointment, please bring in proof and notify the office in advance if you need to collect your child early.
- Book Bags and PE kits are required in school every day.
- Dinner money is £12:50 per week. This needs to be paid in advance on a Monday, payable through Schoolmoney. We cannot extend credit. Changes to lunch arrangements must be provided to the office giving 2 weeks notice.
- School uniform should be worn at all times and clearly labelled with your child's name. We do keep stock which can be ordered from 'The Shop' in Schoolmoney. We do keep stock We will contact you when your order is ready for collection.
- We have a substantial amount of good quality second-hand uniform in school and by way of helping families will be offering you the chance to 'help yourself' to these items. We will let you know the date but expect it to be before half term.
- The weather is changing daily and ask that you send your child in with a coat.
- Long hair needs to be tied back. Any hair coverings or accessories must be in school colours. Children should not have colours in their hair for school. No jewellery other than stud earrings should be worn.
- If anyone, other than yourself is collecting your child from school, you need to let us know by 1pm. We will not release your children to anyone without prior notification. We will question anyone you have sent to collect your children on your behalf without speaking to

Road Safety

You will be aware of all the amazing work our Junior Leaders have done over the last few years to improve safety on Grendon Road. This includes, working with 3 local councillors, park and stride initiatives, posters outside school, the speed camera and double yellow lines on Grendon Road and a Clean Air Monitor on our school building. Despite this, congestion on Grendon Road seems worse than ever at the start of this term. This is not a behaviour that we can change ourselves - we need your support. Wherever possible, please park further away and walk the final part to school. If you are parking, <u>DO NOT PARK OVER DRIVEWAYS</u> OR BLOCK PATHWAYS. We constantly receive complaints from local residents and ask that you be considerate when parking your car. Residents have been advised to contact Billesley Police with any parking issues/abusive behaviour.
