

Feel Good Friday

On the last day of each half term, children will be taking part in Feel Good Friday in school. Feel Good Friday delivers our Grendon Goal 'Nurture our Health and Wellbeing' and is part of our whole school 'Wellbeing Strategy' which is focussed on supporting children's physical, emotional and mental health.



On Feel Good Friday, children will spend time with their class and class teacher and will do an activity they have planned together.
