Parent/carers will also receive their child's offer by letter from 2 March 2024.


Waiting lists in Birmingham will not be made available for families until Monday 25 March 2024. Waiting list information will not be available before that date.

We achieved our gold RRSA award in 2022 and are proud to currently be one of only 40 Birmingham Schools who hold the award.

Being a rights respecting school means we teach children ABOUT, FOR and THROUGH their rights under the 1991 United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC). Holding this award demonstrates that our school puts children's well-being and supporting children to achieve their full potential at the heart of our school. Children are taught about equality, dignity, respect, non-discrimination and participation. They learn about themselves as global citizens.

Children have children's rights lessons each half term and our assemblies also link to the UNCRC.

#### Reception Place Offers: Process for September 2024

If you applied online and provided an email address, an email will be sent to you from Birmingham City Council on **Tuesday 16th April 2024**, to tell you which primary school your child has been offered. We cannot guarantee the exact time you will receive your email as this depends on your service provider. However, it is expected that you will receive your offer by 4pm on Tuesday 16 April 2024.

They will also send a formal offer letter posted by 1st class post on Tuesday 16 April 2024; allow at least three working days for your letter to arrive.

The offer letter will explain how to accept or refuse the offer that has been made. Do not contact Birmingham City Council before you have received the offer of a school place.

The school admissions team cannot tell you which primary school place has been offered to your child by phone or email. You must have received your email or letter before contacting the school admissions team.

If you have not received your email or letter by Monday 22 April 2024, you may contact school admissions.
