Sustainable Drainage Project

You may remember that a while ago, I shared news that we had received funding from the Government to reduce the risk of flooding in severe weather. This has happened in the past due to the position and slope of our school site. The project team have already visited our Year 5 classes earlier in the year during their learning about Rivers, in order to discuss the problems that flooding can cause.

I am now pleased to say that this project has been given the green light and will commence on Monday. The work will be in the back playground and we will have contractors on site. There will be little disruption to school. We are able to carry on as normal throughout the project.

I will share updates as this project progresses, but we look forward to this being successful in the storage, slow release and re-routing of potential flood water away from school.
