Dear Parents and Carers

In Year 6 this term, the theme for your child's learning in PSHE will be all about '**Me and My Relationships**'.

As part of this theme...

- Children learn about friendships, positive relationships, conflict resolution, managing relationships and developing appropriate assertive skills.
- Children are taught to build self-esteem about inappropriate touch and reference is made to FGM. This is part of our normal SCARF PSHE Scheme and this particular lesson has been flagged as 'sensitive but not optional' as the lesson considers different touch-appropriate, inappropriate and illegal. Resources used in the lesson include a reference to FGM, although the term is not used.
