Curriculum

In Year Six, we focus on reading, writing and maths each morning.

During Reading lessons, children will read a variety of different texts and they will predict, analyse, clarify and discuss themes found within them. We will work on children reading at speed, gaining a good understanding and being able to answer a range of questions linked to the text.

In Maths, we begin by consolidating place value and then we work on children calculating confidently across all four operations in a range of contexts.

In English lessons, we will be writing in a range of styles, ensuring that word choices, punctuation and tense are accurate.



Curriculum cont.

In the afternoons, the children will learn about the Vikings in History, electricity in Science and we will be learning how to describe ourselves in French. Alongside this, the children will take part in PSHE, RE and Grammar lessons.

For PE this half term, the children will be swimming. **6N will swim on Tuesdays and 6B will swim on Fridays.**

Graffiti Workshop

In Year 6, children will have the exciting opportunity to participate in an Expert Led Graffiti Workshop on Thursday 7th November. Children will be taught how to create their own graffiti artwork and will be able to take home their very own personalised graffiti work. Many former Year 6 children have said this was their highlight of the year. More information about this exciting workshop will follow.

Secondary Schools

It probably seems rather early to be thinking about where your child will be going to secondary school, but sadly it isn't.

The deadline for applying is **31st October 2024**.

Your child is less likely to be offered a place at their chosen schools if you miss the deadline for applications.

Birmingham City Council will then send offers of school places on National Offer Day 3rd March 2025.

Homework

Homework will consist of children reading their reading books, spellings, TTRS and My Maths. There will be a weekly spelling test and a History Homework task (both of these will be sent separately). Please remember that all homework is set through Microsoft Teams. Children should know their logins but a new login sheet will be given to the children.

SATs

The 2025 Key Stage 2 SATs will take place in the week commencing 12th May 2025. The tests will take place over four days. Over this period, children will sit 6 different tests in Reading, Maths and Grammar. More detailed information and a Parents Workshop will follow during the Spring Term.
