Children will create a painting that captures emotion in the cubist/expressionist style PICASSO (1905-1920)

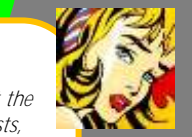

Children will create their own wire sculpture inspired by the work of artist Alexander Calder

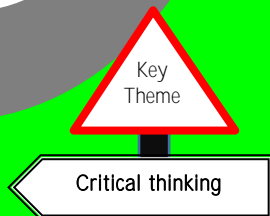
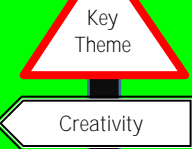
