
We will celebrate our birthdays by giving each child a special card made by other children in school.

Daily Routines

Children will need to line up outside Reception gates to be collected at 8.50 from the playground. Once we have settled into school we will introduce soft start like the rest of the school from 8.40am. We will inform you when the children are ready to do this. At the end of the school day, the bell will ring at 3.20pm and staff will bring the children down to the blue gates. Please stay on the outside of the gates and wait for staff to hand your child back to you, please ensure you are visible to us so that we can make this process as smooth as possible. If we need to speak to you at the end of the day we will send your child with a circle asking for you to wait and see us. Please bare with us while we dismiss all of the other children safely.



Snacks and water

Please send a bottle of water into school everyday for your child. The children can have squash/juice for lunch time and snack but only water in the classroom. You are welcome to send two bottles into school.



Children have fruit provided at school for their snack. However, if you would like to provide your own snack this must be healthy, e.g. cereal bar, fruit or yogurt. Please refrain from sending crisps or chocolate or anything that may contain **nuts**.

We are learning about..

This first part of the term is all about helping children to follow the routines to get them settled into school. We know this can be an exciting but possibly anxious time for some children and we aim to support them so that they feel confident and happy. We will shortly be beginning our work around, "Who can help us?". Children will be thinking about who in our world can help us and how they work hard to keep us safe. We will start daily phonics soon so be ready for your children to tell you all about Fred our phonics frog!
