Please ensure that all items of school uniform are named.

- Children are allowed to wear stud earrings only. No other types of jewellery should be worn.
- Watches may be worn if they do not interfere with teaching and learning, however smart watches should not be worn or brought to school. In this case, staff will keep the watch safe and return to parents at the end of the day.
- Children should have natural hair. Hair should not be coloured.
- Hairstyles should be appropriate for school and the age of the child and long hair should be tied back.
- Children should have natural nails. Nail polish, fake nails or acrylic nails should not be worn to school.
- Children should not wear make-up.
