Curriculum

In Maths, we will be learning about fractions, mass and capacity, time and shape. Please remember to complete your weekly MyMaths and Times Tables Rockstars work at home. Children need to know their 2,5,10,3,4 and 8 times tables by the end of the year!

In English, we will continue to develop our fiction and non-fiction writing. Children will still receive a reading task to complete at home each week and spellings, which can be found on TEAMS, will still be tested each Friday.

In Science, we will be learning about plants for the rest of the year. We cannot wait for our visit to the Botanical gardens in June! We will be posting a Science homework task on TEAMS at the end of the week.



In DT, we will be designing and making a moving toy using cams.

Our Computing unit will teach children how to digitally make a poster.

In PE, we are no longer swimming! We will be learning how to play rounders, taking part in athletics in preparation for Sports Day and completing outdoor adventurous activities. Please remember to send in your child's PE kit which is to be kept on their peg in school.



In French, children will learn how to retell the story of Petit Chaperon Rouge.

Our PSHE lessons will focus on Being My Best and Changing and Growing.

In History, we will learn about life in Ancient Egypt.



In Art, we will learn about producing art work using the mixed media of digital technology and textiles. We will be setting a homework project based on this after half term.
