As a school we will:

- Put the safety of our staff and your children first.
- * Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the Covid-19 pandemic.

- Follow Birmingham City Council and Public Health England guidance in response to a positive test from staff or children.

As a family we will:

- * Read all messages and emails that are sent home and keep up to date with the school website.
- Wear a face covering if coming to school on public transport.
- * Drop off and collect children at the right time, using the right entrance and exit.
- * Main a social distance at all times while on school site.
- Use the school office only when an email or phone call won't help and only between 9.10am and 9.30am.
- Provide children with a drink and snack for playtime, a water bottle for use in the classroom and a packed lunch if they are not having school dinners.
- * Ensure children only bring into school items that they will need for their lessons.
- * Remind children about social distancing and model this whenever possible.
- Not send children into school if they show any of the 3 symptoms of Covid-19 and contact school immediately if this is the case.
- * Not send children into school if anybody in the household shows any of the 3 symptoms of Covid-19 and inform school immediately.
- * Engage with the test and trace system and make school aware of the test result.
- * Ensure that if a test is positive, that person isolates for 7 days and the rest of the household for 14 days.

Parent's Signature:

As children we will:

- Only enter and exit school through the right gate at the right time.
- Line up sensibly on the marks for our class in the playground.
- Not use any outside play equipment that is out of use and taped off.
- * Only bring the things to school that we need for the day.
- * Wash our hands carefully for 20 seconds with soap and water or use hand sanitiser when we are asked to.
- Cough or sneeze into a tissue or our elbow and follow the catch it—bin it—kill it instructions.
- * Do our best not to get too close to our friends or to touch other people in school.
- * Follow our behavior policy at all times.
- * Talk to an adult if we feel unwell or if we are worried or nervous about anything.
- Follow any instructions given because we know that they are to keep us all safe.
