Curriculum

At the end of year 4, all children take a times table test. This is new and will test all times tables up to 12×12 .

What if my child does badly in their multiplication tables check?

We will help them to get better!

It is also important to note that all children will be tested on is their times tables knowledge - with no problem solving skills being assessed and not even a single division question being asked!

Children in Year 4 will only be asked times tables questions, like $3 \times 3 = 9$.
