Our Academic Curriculum

Our academic curriculum provides effective structure and opportunity.

Our children learn subject specific knowledge and skills in lessons that are either taught each week or in blocks at different times in the year.

We know that they do best when they make links in learning between different subjects or across different year groups. Our curriculum reflects this.

We have a strong focus on developing reading, writing and maths skills, knowledge and understanding across the curriculum.

Lessons are planned creatively and focus on developing independence, resilience and communication skills in learners.

Our children enjoy learning because of the rich, purposeful experiences that we offer. Our Grendon Passport, Enterprise Scheme, whole school theme days and a range of before and after school clubs and activities enhance learning.

Our children have the opportunity to play a musical instrument and even join the school orchestra!

As a result, children at Grendon make good progress.





Our Pastoral Curriculum

Our pastoral curriculum removes barriers and develops strength of character.

Our curriculum reflects the value and importance of teaching tolerance and respect. RE, PSHE, British Values and children's rights lessons are a regular part of our timetable.

This helps build strong relationships across our diverse community.

Our behaviour policy supports the happy and calm working atmosphere as children aim to 'stay in gold'. We make it easy for children to seek support from staff with any problems or concerns and make it clear that bullying is never acceptable.

We work with outside agencies such as the school nurse and speech therapist and can access other help and support as required.


We encourage collaboration, with older children working as play leaders in the playground and as learning buddies in classrooms.

As a result, children are happy, healthy and ready to learn.









We have three playgrounds and a sports field, walks, a stage, a meadow, a football cage, tyre parks, a climbing wall, a pergola (for shade in the summer), a pond and vegetable garden, a waiting shelter and a spinney. We also have a fantastic greenhouse that we made from plastic bottles!

We are very proud of our school garden too . All children participate in gardening lessons. We have even grown, harvested, prepared and cooked our own produce!
